Launch of India@75 (Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav) campaign by NACO

Government of India has launched an intensive, country wide campaign – 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' which will focus on citizen participation, to be converted into a 'Janandolan' where small changes, at the local level, will add up to significant national gains.
